

- •Courthouse Lake is a designated trout lake.
- •The lakeshed area to lakeshed ratio is 8:1, which means the lakeshed can contribute a moderate amount of nutrients to the lake.
- •Swimming and the use of boats are prohibited in Courthouse Lake.
- •The major land use within the watershed is natural (62%).
- •The water clarity, measured with the Secchi disk, is well above the state standard for deep lakes but declined from 2009.
- •In 1994 a total reclamation of the lake took place. Since then, significant numbers (approximately 3000) of trout are stocked in Courthouse Lake each year.
- •This fall (2010) the aerator installed in 2009 to help with low dissolved oxygen was turned on again..
- •There is no fish consumption information available for this lake.
